

No. 1219-D-A.B.—In exercise of the power conferred by Sub-section (3), Section 3, of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to confirm Notification No. 543-Y, dated the 17th December 1920, published in the *Central Provinces Gazette* of the 25th idem, so far as it relates to the monuments described in the schedule below:—
